

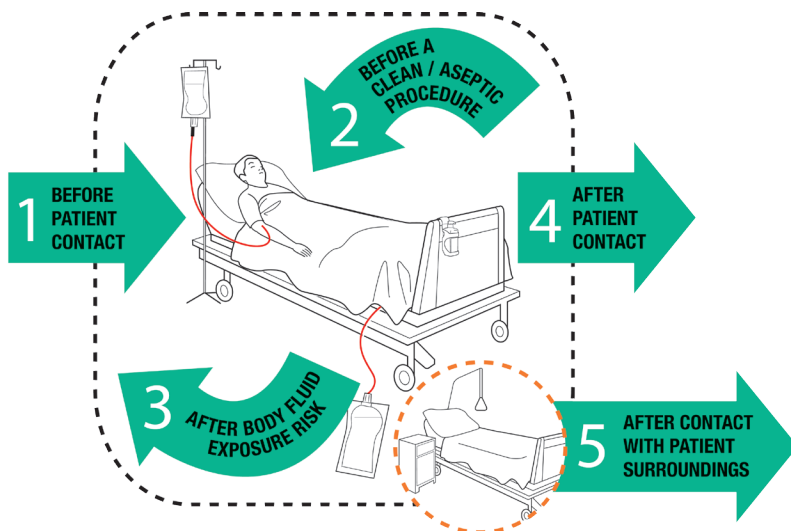

Let's talk about the **WHO 5 Moments Guidelines** for Hand Hygiene.

W.H.O. 5 Moments:



- 1 Before patient contact**
 To protect the patient against harmful germs carried on your hands
- 2 Before a clean/aseptic procedure**
 To protect the patient against harmful germs, entering his or her body
- 3 After body fluid exposure risk**
 To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs
- 4 After patient contact**
 To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs
- 5 After contact with patient surroundings**
 To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs

The World Health Organization defines point-of-care as the place where three elements come together:

- ✓ The patient
- ✓ The healthcare worker
- ✓ Care or treatment involving contact with the patient or his/her surroundings within the patient zone
